






## Safety

- Read these instructions carefully and retain for future reference.
- Before using for the first time, remove all packaging and any labels. Wash the parts: see 'Cleaning'.
- Do not use the juicer if the filter is damaged.
- Turn the speed control to 'O' OFF position and unplug:
  - before fitting or removing parts
  - before cleaning
  - after use.
- Never use a damaged attachment. Get it checked or repaired: see 'service and customer care'.
- Only use the pusher supplied. Never put your fingers in the feed tube. Unplug and remove the lid before unblocking the feed tube.
- Before removing the lid, switch off, wait for the filter to stop and remove the whole attachment from the outlet of the Stand Mixer.
- Do not over fill the feed tube or use excessive force to push the food down the feed tube you could damage your attachment.
- Do not process frozen fruit or vegetables. Allow to defrost before processing.
- Do not process dried or hard ingredients such as grains, fruit with hard seeds or ice as they may damage the attachment.
- Do not touch moving parts.
- Never leave the attachment switched on unattended.
- Never use an unauthorised attachment, or more than one attachment at once.
- Misuse of your attachment can result in injury.
- Do not operate your appliance near the edge, or overhanging the work surface or apply force to the attachment when fitted, as this may cause the unit to become unstable and tip over, which may result in injury.



- Do not move or raise the mixer head with an attachment fitted as the Stand Mixer could become unstable.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Appliances can be used by persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and if they understand the hazards involved.

• Only use the appliance for its intended domestic use. Kenwood will not accept any liability if the appliance is subject to improper use, or failure to comply with these instructions.

Cleaning

- Drive unit Wipe with a damp cloth, then dry. Do no immerse in water.
- Do not clean the pulp or filter outlet with a sharp pointed object such as the end of a knife as you will damage the bowl. Use the tip of the cleaning brush handle to clean the outlets.
- Use the brush supplied to clean the filter. For best results, rinse under water and brush until clear.

• This appliance conforms to EC Regulation 1935/2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

This attachment features the Twist Connection System () and is designed to fit directly on the latest generation Kenwood Chef models (identified as TYPE KVC, KVL, KCC, KWL and KCL).

This attachment can also fit KMix Stand Mixers featuring a slow speed attachment outlet (TYPE KMX).

To check that this attachment is compatible with your Stand Mixer you will need to ensure both components feature the Twist Connection System

If your Stand Mixer features the Bar Connection System (a) you will also need an adaptor before operation is possible. The reference code for the adaptor is KATO01ME. For more information and how to order the adaptor visit *www.kenwoodworld.com.*

## To Assemble your Juicer

## Refer to Illustrations C - J

## C - D

Fit the pulp stopper into the opening on the underside of the juicing bowl (6) and push in until secure.

## E - F

Fit the juicing bowl (6) to the drive unit by aligning the  $\bigcirc$  on the side of the bowl with the 1 on the drive unit. To lock the bowl on turn it clockwise until the 1 ine up with the 1 on the drive unit.



Place the filter basket ④ into the wiper holder ⑤.

Н

Lower the wiper holder assembly into the juicing bowl and align the **>** with the **-** on the top of the drive unit. Ensure that the filter basket is locked into place.



Place the scroll ③ into the filter basket and push down to secure. **Note: the lid cannot be fitted if the scroll is not fully pushed down.** 

## J

Fit the lid ② onto the unit ensuring the lines up with the O on top of the drive unit. Then turn the lid clockwise until it clicks into place and the O lines up with the O on top of the drive unit. Place the food pusher ① into the feed tube.

## To Use your Juicer

#### Refer to Illustrations K - N

## Κ

Lift off the slow speed outlet cover.

#### L

With the attachment in the position shown locate to the slow speed outlet and rotate to lock into place.

## M - N

Place a bowl under the pulp spout ⑦ and place the juice jug ⑫ under the juice spout ⑧. Ensure the anti-drip stopper ⑨ is in the open position before juicing.

• Use the recommended usage chart as a guide for juicing different fruits and vegetables.

Switch to speed 6 on your Stand Mixer and feed the food items down slowly using the pusher until processed. Note: The wiper holder is designed to rotate during operation.


 To extract the maximum amount of juice, always push the food down slowly using the pusher. Do not use excessive force as the food should be pulled down by the scroll. After adding the last piece of food, allow the juicer to run to help clear the juice from the juicing bowl. The time will vary depending on the fruit type and thickness of the juice extracted.

## 0

Switch off and wait until the final flow of juice has reduced to a few slow drips. Then place the anti-drip stopper (9) in position before removing the jug.

#### Refer to the troubleshooting section if you experience any problems with the operation of the attachment.

- Clutch operation
   There is an internal clutch designed to
   protect the attachment in the event
   that it becomes jammed. An occasional
   "clicking" sound in use is normal
   operation, however if food becomes
   jammed in the feed tube or scroll and the
   juicer stops operating, which results in a
   continual "clicking" sound, switch off the
   Stand Mixer and remove the attachment.
- Once the attachment is removed from the Stand Mixer, remove the lid and clear the blockage. If the lid is jammed and difficult to remove, use the spanner () provided to turn the attachment drive shaft in an anticlockwise direction until the food becomes dislodged and the lid can be removed.
   Once the food is released re-assemble the attachment and re-fit to the Stand Mixer.



## Juicer Hints and Tips

- Wash all fruit and vegetable thoroughly before juicing.
- To maximise juice extraction place small quantities at a time in the feed tube and push down slowly.
- Hard foods are best juiced at room temperature.
- You do not have to remove thin peels or skins. Only remove thick peels that you would not eat e.g. those of oranges, pineapples, melons and uncooked beetroots.
- Use fresh fruit and vegetables as they contain more juice.
- Remove stones and hard seeds from cherries, plums etc.
- Vitamins disappear the sooner you drink your juice, the more vitamins you will get.
- If you need to store the juice for a few hours put it in the fridge. It will keep better if you add a few drops of lemon juice.

#### **Health Recommendations**

- Do not drink more than three 230mls (8 fl.oz.) glasses of juice a day unless you are used to it.
- Dilute juice for children with an equal amount of water.
- Juice from dark green (broccoli, spinach etc.) or dark red (beetroot, red cabbage etc.) vegetables is extremely strong, so always dilute it.
- Fruit juice is high in Fructose (fruit sugar), so people with diabetes or low blood sugar should avoid drinking too much.

## Care and Cleaning

#### Refer to Illustration Q

- Always switch off, unplug and take the juicer apart before cleaning.
- Some discolouration of parts may occur upon using ingredients such as carrot or leafy vegetables.

Cleaning all parts immediately after each use will help to reduce stains.

 Do not clean the pulp or filter outlet with a sharp pointed object such as the end of a knife as you will damage the bowl. Use the tip of the cleaning brush handle to clean the outlets.

#### Drive unit

- Wipe with a damp cloth, then dry.
- Do not immerse in water.

#### Filter

- To assist with removal of pulp and fibres, place the anti-drip stopper in the closed position. Switch the juicer on and pour approximately 300mls water down the feed tube. Operate the juicer for approximately 20 seconds, place the juice jug under the juice spout and open the stopper to allow the water to flow out.
- Always clean the filter basket immediately after juicing.
- Use the brush supplied to clean the filter. For best results, rinse under water and brush until clear.

#### Wiper holder

 The wipers in the filter holder can be removed for cleaning. To assemble, Insert the upper/lower wipers into the gap of the filter holder and secure. Ensure that the wipers are replaced and fitted correctly before assembling the juicer.
